German Research

Robert (Bob) Rau will provide an introduction to doing genealogical research on Germanic ancestors, starting with finding the place of origin in Germany, and then finding and using the available records to trace the ancestral lines back in time. It will include a slide presentation.

He was active in the microfilming of German Lutheran and Evangelical church records from Cincinnati and Southeastern Indiana, and is a member of numerous genealogical societies.
